SOP or GTE has been replaced by the new Genuine Student Responses

- There are 5 questions in this section which must be completed
- You must provide supporting documentation as evidence for each claim you make in a response
- Each question is limited to 1m0000 characters (including spaces and punctuation) this must be answered in the form  
Do not attach a separate document answering these questions. Stay within the word limit
- Response to all 5 questions if questions 5 is not applicable, you must write " not applicable" in the field  
(do not leave it blank)
- Question 4 is your chance to provide other details to support the applicants claim to be a Genuine Student

## RESPONSE 1

Give details of your current circumstances, including ties to family, community, employment and economic circumstances

- You must comment on and provide evidence of your family, social, cultural, religious, and financial/economic ties to your home country
- You must support your stated this with documentary evidence and the evidence must clearly demonstrate significant incentives for you to return to your home country upon completion of your degree.
- Attach supporting evidence for each claim

## RESPONSE 2

Explain why you wish to study this course in Australia with name of uni, including your clear understanding of the requirements of the intended course and studying and living in Australia ( max; 1,000 characters)

- You must show that you have a good understanding of Australia and Name of uni and the course you will study
- Talk about your course structure and any specific units that are of particular interest and that will benefit your future
- Tell us about your campus and why you chose it
- Attach supporting evidence for each claim

### RESPONSE 3

Explain how completing this course will be benefit to you (max 1,0000 characters)

- How is your proposed course relevant to your future employment?
- Show that your proposed course is in demand in your home country
- Demonstrate a strong career plan and how this course will help achieve career goals
- Include information and evidence of your return on investment (ROI) and the economic benefits this course will provide you when you complete
- Attach supporting evidence for each claim

### RESPONSE 4

Give any other relevant details that you'd like to include (max 1,000 characters)

- So not leave this section blank. This is your opportunity to provide further relevant information to support your application
- You should concentrate on demonstrating how you are a genuine student and show us how much you know about your intended course and its impact in your future
- Attach supporting evidence for each claim

## RESPONSE 5

If you have previously studied in Australia, provide a detailed history of your study record in Australia from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of arrival (max 1,000 characters) \*\* if you have previously not studied in Australia, write " not applicable" in the text box

- Give specific details about all study you have previously undertaken in Australia. Including when you completed your course on time, whether you completed all assessment, whether you completed all assessment, whether you changed course and/or providers at any time (and explain why)
- Attach supporting evidence for each claim
